

English

In English, we will be learning all about instructional texts and how these are utilised in real life. We will put this into practice by writing our own recipes. Later on in the term, we will be studying recounts (fiction and non-fiction) and explanation texts.

Maths

We will be learning all about mass, volume and capacity (with lots of practical work!) before moving on to studying money (recognising coins, adding amounts and calculating change) and telling the time (digital and analogue).

Modern Foreign Language

In French, we will be learning how to describe members of our families and to verbalise how many brothers and sisters we have. We will also learn the numbers 0-12 and how to say how old we are.

History

In History, we will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptians. Our unit title is 'How Much Did Ancient Egypt Change Over Time?' We will be exploring pyramids, social structures, religious beliefs, mummification, famous pharaohs and much more!

Geography

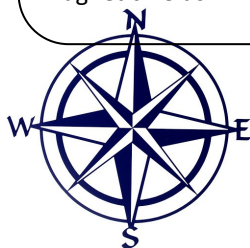
We will be looking at rivers this term. In particular we will be learning about the River Nile and the River Cam. We will take a walk to the River Cam and look at physical and human geography.

Computing

We will be learning all about databases and branching databases and will even create our own! After that, we will be focusing on internet safety and how to stay safe. Following this, we will be studying simulations and how to create our own.

Science

In our 'Light' unit we will be learning what light is, how a shadow is formed, how to manipulate the size and shape of a shadow, all about reflection, and how to stay safe in the sun. We will then be looking at forces, magnets and magnetic fields.

PHSCE

In PSHE, we will be looking at anti-bullying, by-standers, healthy friendships and boundaries. We will also look at how to work together successfully. Before concluding with work on diversity and equality.

RE

In RE, we will be studying Christianity, in particular we will be looking at Jesus's miracles. By the end of the unit, children should show understanding of Christian beliefs on the following questions: Could Jesus heal people? Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?

PE

In PE, we will be continuing to work on our gymnastic skills, looking at patterns and pathways and hand apparatus. For our outdoor session, we will be learning the key skills of orienteering and following a map.

Art

In Art, we will be working on our drawing technique. We will then be looking at how to animate our drawings. In the second half of the term, we will be practising our sewing skills and how to make artwork from paint and thread.

Music

We will be practising our analysis and performance skills using the song 'Three Little Birds' as our stimulus. We will perform as a whole group.

DT

In DT, we will be learning how to prepare food safely. We will be learning cutting and slicing skills. We will put this into practice through designing and creating our own sandwich for a class picnic.
